It should include full bibliographic citations in APA style for all publications, the title, amount and funding agency for funded research projects, and provide the title, date and place of presentations and lectures. - **Affiliated Member (Institutional)**

Interested non-profit organizations whose mandate and activities centre on immigration and settlement issues and who are interested in various informational exchange and/or collaborative initiatives. Institutional members also receive invitations to general meetings, symposia, etc., sponsored by CERIS.

Term: up to three years, renewable.

- **Student Member**

Interested graduate students whose work focuses on immigration and settlement issues. They receive information regarding general meetings, symposia, etc., sponsored by CERIS; access to documentation centre and research databases (on a cost-recovery basis) and are expected to participate in such activities on a regular basis.

Term: up to one year, renewable.
